Measure Description:

Establishes requirements for coverage of autism spectrum disorders by health benefit plans, Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Health Licensing Agency (OHLA)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill requires expanded coverage for autism spectrum disorders by health benefit plans, including plans offered by the Public Employees' Benefit Board and the Oregon Educators' Benefit Board. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill. The amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
