Measure Description:

Requires coordinated care organization to provide oral health care through contracts with dental care organizations.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting this measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The bill requires coordinated care organizations to provide oral health care through contracts with dental care organizations.

This bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority. The full impact of this bill is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
