Measure Description:

Increases share of moneys retained by Oregon Racing Commission from payments received by commission from gross receipts of mutuel wagering recorded by totalizator system.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Racing Commission

Local Government Mandate:

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Business and Labor to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill amends the distribution of proceeds received by the Oregon Racing Commission from gross receipts of mutual wagering. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
