**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Amends definition of "estate" for purposes of calculating medical assistance paid by Department of Human Services or Oregon Health Authority.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

• Request to refer measure to Committee on Rules for further consideration

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Existing statutes allow the state to recover certain amounts from the estate of an individual who received state-provided medical assistance—typically Medicaid payments. Recovery amounts are calculated differently based upon the type of deed on a recipient's home and uncertainty can arise in a situation where there is more than one type of deed on a home.

House Bill 3349 amends the definition of "estate" for purposes of recovery action for medical assistance provided by the state.
