Measure Description:

Changes continuing education requirements for commercial construction contractors.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Construction Contractors Board (CCB)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Business and Transportation to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill changes the way in which the Construction Contractors Board (CCB) operates continuing education programs, eliminating the CCB's provision of certain continuing education programs and fees. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
