Measure Description:

Authorizes governing body of Malheur County to plan and zone up to five sites, containing 1,000 or fewer acres each, for industrial use.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, Department of Land Conservation and Development

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Land Use to the House Committee on Rules. The bill authorizes the governing body of Malheur County to plan and zone up to five sites, containing 1,000 or fewer acres each, for industrial use. The agency or a local government may anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill.
