**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Corrects grammar and punctuation errors in statutes. Conforms language to existing statute and legislative style. Deletes obsolete statutory references.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Purpose of bill is to correct erroneous material in Oregon law
- Clarification that there are no substantive or policy changes in bill

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Every session the Office of Legislative Counsel introduces a “reviser’s bill” to make nonsubstantive changes to Oregon Law. This bill corrects grammar and punctuation errors and deletes obsolete references in Oregon law. House Bill 2148 is this session’s version of the “reviser’s bill.”
