WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Adds the crime of luring a minor (ORS 167.057), and conspiracy involving a sex crime (ORS 161.450) to the list of crimes defined as "Sex Crimes" for purposes of this section. Gives the judge discretion whether or not to designate a conviction of luring a minor as a sex crime. Declares emergency, effective upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Crimes are added to the sex offender registry as a tool for law enforcement to be better able to protect the

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Gives judge discretion to designate the crime of luring a minor, a sex crime, making it necessary for the convicted person to register as a sex offender. Removes the crime of coercion from list of crimes for which registration is required.

BACKGROUND: Senate Bill 30 A adds two crimes to the sex offender registry. The registry was established and is maintained to be a tool for law enforcement officers in helping to protect the public.
