Measure Description:

Directs Department of Transportation to conduct interchange management study as part of redevelopment of Umatilla Chemical Depot.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Business and Transportation to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill makes changes to road usage charges relying on metered usage of vehicles. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
