## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Andrew Keller, of Portland, Oregon, was killed by insurgents in Afghanistan while leading his team in combat on August 15, 2012. He proudly served in the United States Army for eighteen months, and had just deployed to Afghanistan a month before his death. He was 22. For his exceptional service, Andrew Keller was posthumously awarded a Bronze Star, Purple Heart, and Army Commendation Medal. Senate Concurrent Resolution 9 honors Andrew Keller.
