**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Allows a sheriff by agreement with the Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC) to deliver a youth offender directly to the Oregon Youth Authority (OYA). Declares emergency, effective upon passage.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Safety of the juveniles in adult facilities

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Replaces the measure.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently a juvenile fifteen or older, convicted of a Measure 11 offense, or a juvenile waived to adult court for trial is sentenced to the legal custody of the DOC and the physical custody of the OYA. The juvenile will be processed through the DOC intake facility and eventually placed in an OYA facility.
