WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Abolishes Information Resources Management Council and Stakeholders Advisory Committee. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- History of Information Resources Management Council
- Changing needs of Department of Administrative Services
- Enterprise Leadership Team fulfilling functions of Council
- Effort to abolish obsolete entities within state government

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Information Resource Management Council and the Stakeholders Advisory Committee are resource management advisory bodies within the Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS). The Council was established in 1993 through Senate Bill 1130 and its last meeting was held in 2000. Proponents assert that the DAS relies on other advisory bodies to fulfill its functions and that the two advisory bodies are now obsolete.

House Bill 2211 abolishes the Informational Resources Management Council and the Stakeholders Advisory Committee.
