WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Urges Congress to dedicate significant portion of marine and fishery product import tariffs to market Oregon and domestic seafood.

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Currently, more than 80 percent of seafood consumed in the United States is imported from foreign countries. House Joint Memorial 3 urges Congress to support domestic marketing of Oregon seafood and allocate money to a National Seafood Marketing Fund to promote domestic seafood.
