WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows firearm training facilities on land otherwise designated exclusive farm use if the land is not defined as high value as defined in ORS 195.300.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Difficulty in locating firearm training facilities in Oregon
- Need for more firearm training facilities
- Environmental issues

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Allows firearm training facility on farmland not to be determined as high value as defined in ORS 195.300.

**BACKGROUND:** "Firearm training facility" is an indoor or outdoor facility that provides training courses and issues certificates required: (1) For law enforcement personnel; (2) By the State Department of Fish and Wildlife; (3) By a nationally recognized programs that promote shooting matches, target shooting and safety. "Firearm training facilities" in existence on September 9, 1995 are allowed to continue to operate until such time as the facility is no longer used as a firearm training facility.
