WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Clarifies that committee formed by Department of Education (ODE) and Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) is established to set goals, develop grant criteria, review grant applications and make recommendations related to awarding grants under Career and Technical Education Revitalization Grant Program. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Technical nature of the measure
- Consensus recommendations in measure result of work group
- Contents of measure aimed at memorializing valuable lessons learned from initial implementation of grant program, with focus on sustainable expansion of program

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: House Bill 3362 (2011) established the Career and Technical Education Revitalization Grant Program for the purpose of awarding grants to enhance collaboration on Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs between education providers and employers. House Bill 2913 clarifies that ODE and BOLI jointly establish a committee to set goals for the program, develop criteria, review all grant applications and make recommendations related to the awarding of grants. The measure further specifies that the committee membership must represent business, industry, labor and education providers.
