WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Adds luring a minor (ORS 167.057), and conspiracy involving a sex crime (ORS 161.450) to the list of crimes defined as “Sex Crimes” for purposes of this section. Gives the Judge discretion whether or not to designate a conviction of luring a minor as a sex crime. Declares emergency, effective upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- The Sex Offender Registry is a necessary law enforcement tool

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Senate Bill 30 A adds two crimes to the sex offender registry. The registry was established and is maintained to be a tool for law enforcement officers in helping to protect the public.
