WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Prohibits agency required by law to appoint rulemaking advisory committee from appointing officer, employee, or agent of agency to serve on advisory committee.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Provisions of measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: It is the policy of the State of Oregon that the public be involved in the development of public policy and rulemaking of state agencies. As part of the public input process, an agency may appoint a rulemaking advisory committee to represent the interests of affected parties, provide input on fiscal impact, and determine whether a rule will have any significant adverse impact.

House Bill 2560A would prevent an individual from being appointed to a rulemaking advisory committee if the individual is an officer, employee or agent of the appointing agency and if the agency is required by law to appoint the advisory committee.
