**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Directs district school boards to establish policy for reporting incidents that result in injury. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

MEASURE: HB 3045 A

**CARRIER: Sen. Hass** 

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Account of Alice Scoggin, bus driver, who was attacked multiple times by a student; she sustained multiple
  injuries; documentation of initial incident not executed correctly (lost paperwork, video not saved); second
  attack by same student required hospitalization
- History of supervisors dissuading employees from reporting injuries
- "Vast majority" of injuries caused by student attacks
- Measure as enabling culture change within schools, combating culture that allows underreporting

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Reporting of school-based injuries is not consistent on a statewide basis. House Bill 3045-A requires all districts to have a reporting policy for all injuries on school property, and requires annual reporting to the Oregon Department of Education.
