Measure Description:

Specifies authority of Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to certify building inspectors in multiple specialty codes; allows the Director to appoint building inspector to perform inspections throughout a geographic region; and gives the Director authority to adopt rules to promote consistency and reduce confusion regarding enforcement of state building codes and in licensing requirements. The measure also eliminates sunset on provisions for training, qualifying and certifying specialized building inspectors.

Analysis:
