**Measure Description:**

Allows person who is at least 16 years of age to register to vote; requires that information provided on voter registration card not be disclosed as a public record until the person turns 18; prevents using voter registration to elect political party affiliation.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Secretary of State

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
