Measure Description:

Requires chief petitioners to perform criminal records checks on paid circulators.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

District Attorneys and their Deputies, Secretary of State, Oregon State Police (OSP), Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI), Cities, Counties, Judicial Department

Analysis:
