Measure Description:

Requires that construction contractor license application filed by limited partnership include name and address of certain limited partnership members; establishes new license types for locksmiths and home inspection services; defines “worker leasing company”; modifies definition of nonexempt contractors for licensing purposes.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Construction Contractors Board (CCB)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
