WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes individual licensed to practice medicine or podiatry in another state or country to provide health care services for out-of-state athletic team under certain circumstances.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Administrative costs of having team doctors licensed in multiple states
- Provisions of the bill

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Current statute limits the practice of medicine in Oregon to individuals properly licensed in this state. Senate Bill 806 modifies existing statute to allow an athletic team physician (M.D./D.O.) or podiatrist who is licensed to practice in another state to provide services to an out-of-state athletic team in Oregon under specified conditions.
