Measure Description:

Allows slaughtering, processing and selling up to 1,000 poultry as outright permitted nonfarm use, subject to specified limits, in areas zoned for exclusive farm use.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Agriculture, Counties

Analysis:
