**Measure Description:**

Modifies laws governing seizure of abandoned vessels.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Oregon State Marine Board, Oregon State Police (OSP), Cities, Counties, Department of Corrections, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission

**Analysis:**
