Measure Description:

Requires employer who fails to provide meal period or rest period breaks in accordance with rules adopted by Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to pay additional one and one-half hours of wages for each day employer is in violation of rules.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
