Measure Description:

Amends list of state agencies and public universities required to adopt integrated pest management practices.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Department of Agriculture, Department of Corrections, Department of Forestry, Department of State Lands, Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD), Oregon University System (OUS), Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:
