**Measure Description:**

Expands crime of assault in third degree to include, under certain circumstances, causing physical injury to person employed at state mental hospital.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Judicial Department, Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Department of Corrections, Department of Justice, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Oregon State Police (OSP), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), Public Defense Services Commission

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have  
**MINIMAL EXPENDITURE IMPACT**
