Measure Description:

Authorizes conditional discharge of person found guilty of unlawful possession of prescription drug.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Corrections, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Oregon State Police (OSP), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), Public Defense Services Commission, Cities, Counties

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
