Measure Description:

Allows Chief Justice of Supreme Court to adopt rules governing use of electronic applications for all state court records and for transmission of jury information to circuit courts.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Council on Court Procedures, Department of Justice, Judicial Department, Public Defense Services Commission, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Cities, Counties

Analysis:
