Measure Description:

Creates crime of interference with state forestland management in the second degree.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Corrections, Department of Forestry, Department of Justice, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Oregon State Police (OSP), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), Public Defense Services Commission

Analysis:
