**Measure Description:**

Provides that device seized by law enforcement agency as gray machine must be returned if prosecution for crime of possession of gray machine is not commenced within six months after seizure.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon State Police (OSP), Public Defense Services Commission, Cities, Counties

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
