Measure Description:

Modifies crime of patronizing a prostitute.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Corrections, Department of Justice, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Public Defense Services Commission, Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST)

Analysis:
