**Measure Description:**

Increases age of runaway and homeless youth for whom Department of Human Services must recommend policies for system of services and support from 18 to 21 years.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Department of Education, Department of Human Services (DHS), Employment Department, Housing and Community Services Department, Oregon Youth Authority (OYA)

**Analysis:**
