Measure Description:

Requires Department of Human Services to disclose case plan and written information to court appointed special advocate in juvenile dependency proceedings.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS), Department of Justice, Judicial Department, Public Defense Services Commission, Oregon Youth Authority, Legislative Administration, district attorneys

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
