

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

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Measure Description:

Requires, under specified circumstances, certain professional regulatory boards to issue authorization to practice profession to spouse or domestic partner of active member of Armed Forces who is subject of military transfer to Oregon.

Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, Board of Chiropractic Examiners, Board of Licensed Social Workers, Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Therapists, Board of Dentistry, Board of Examiners of Licensed Dietitians, State Board of Massage Therapists [Semi-Independent Agency], Mortuary and Cemetery Board, Board of Naturopathic Examiners, Board of Nursing, Board of Optometry [Semi-Independent Agency], Board of Pharmacy, Oregon Medical Board, Occupational Therapy Licensing Board, Physical Therapist Licensing Board [Semi-Independent Agency], Board of Psychologist Examiners, Board of Medical Imaging, Veterinary Medical Examining Board, Oregon Health Licensing Agency (OHLA), Teachers Standards and Practices Commission

Analysis:
