Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Health Authority and the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation to report to the legislature during each calendar quarter on the efforts to coordinate eligibility and enrollment processes for qualified health plans and the state medical assistance program.

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:
