

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure: SB 683 - A

Seventy-Seventh Oregon Legislative Assembly – 2013 Regular Session

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Measure Description:

Prohibits health care practitioners from limiting patient referrals to health care entities in which practitioner or practitioner’s immediate family member has a beneficial interest, or to entities which employ the practitioner.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Board of Dentistry, Board of Medical Imaging, Board of Nursing, Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Health Licensing Agency (OHLA), Oregon Medical Board

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
MINIMAL EXPENDITURE IMPACT
on state or local government.
