

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

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Measure Description:

Removes, from health insurance coverage requirements for chemical dependency and mental or nervous conditions, exemption for treatment resulting from conviction of driving while under influence of intoxicants.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Judicial Department (OJD)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
