Measure Description: Requires a district school board to adopt specified standards in admitting nonresident students either under a contract or by giving consent. Stipulates that such admitted students to the school district be considered as residents of that school district, beginning with those seeking admission in the 2014-15 school year. Specifies that the State School Fund distribution reflect this change, starting with the 2014-15 distribution.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): This bill does not change the total formula revenue available for distribution to school districts and education service districts. It has a subsequent referral to the House Revenue Committee. Detailed analysis will be done when the bill is in that that committee.
