Measure Description:

Modifies method for determining amount of grants-in-aid for beginning teacher and administrator mentorship program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, School Districts

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This bill would alter the method for determining the amount of grants-in-aid for implementing research based high quality mentoring programs for beginning teachers and administrators.

The -2 amendment removes the current cap of \$5,000 on mentoring grants per teacher/administrator. This could result in either increased, or possibly, decreased grants to school districts. The actual effect on the grants is unknown at this time.
