

**FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION**

**Measure: SB 683 – B**

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**Measure Description:**

Requires health care practitioners to inform patients that they may receive tests, treatments or services at a different facility than the facility they are referred to by the health care practitioner.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Board of Dentistry, Board of Medical Imaging, Board of Nursing, Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Health Licensing Agency (OHLA), Oregon Medical Board

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
