Measure Description:

Alters method by which moneys are distributed to school districts for purpose of paying for costs of education of students in eligible day treatment programs and eligible residential treatment programs.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, Education Service Districts (ESD), School Districts

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Revenue to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill makes changes to State School Fund distributions. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
