Measure Description:

Allows Chief Justice of Supreme Court to adopt rules governing use of electronic applications for all state court records and for transmission of jury information to circuit courts.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions):

The measure as amended changes the amount that the local courts transfer to the CFA, which will result in a reduction to state funds. This statement is issued to facilitate the move to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Impact Explanation:

Amendments are consistent with the concepts in the original HB 2857 by reducing the amount that municipal and justice courts send back to the state for the criminal fine account from \$60 to \$44. Establishes parity between local courts and the state on amounts after the state transfer of \$44. Payment of the last \$16 of violations will go to the county treasurer as of July 31, 2013.

The measure will be referred to ways and means where the revenue impact will be further examined.
