**Measure Description:** Specifies that a student in a long term care facility or a skilled nursing facility be considered a resident of a school district in which such facilities are located. Applies to the 2013-14 school year. Takes effect on July 1, 2013.

**Revenue Impact:** This bill does not change the total formula revenue available to school districts and education service districts.

**Impact Explanation:** While this bill does not change the total formula revenue available to school districts and education service districts, it will cause a shift of formula revenue among school districts. The bill changes the residency of a student in a long term care or a skilled nursing facility, from the district where the student's parent or guardian resides to the district where the facility is located. 31 students are identified to be affected by this residency change.
