Summary of Revenue Changes

The Oceangoing Research Vessel Program is established with a General Fund allocation to the Oregon University System (OUS). Because OUS was shifted from a state agency to a public university system in 2011, the funds are appropriated to the Department of Administrative Services for distribution to OUS.

Summary of Education Subcommittee Action

House Bill 3451 establishes the Oceangoing Research Vessel Program at Oregon State University (OSU) to conduct specified marine research activities. The U.S. National Science Foundation owns a fleet of research vessels stationed in multiple coastal states. The operation of these vessels is usually funded by a mix of federal support, state funding and research grants. These vessels perform a variety of research, normally in conjunction with state universities, in the immediately surrounding coastal waters. At this time, Oregon is the only state with a federally-funded research vessel, RV Oceanus, which does not designate any state funding for vessel operations. House Bill 3451 appropriates funds to operate RV Oceanus and creates a program at Oregon State University to utilize the vessel. The bill also creates the Research Vessel Council with specified members appointed by OSU's president that may include representatives of state natural resource agencies. The bill directs OSU to report to interim legislative committees related to education no later than November 30, 2015 on research conducted under the program, including scholarly findings, future research needs, and the sufficiency of federal support for ongoing operations.

The bill appropriates \$300,000 General Fund for distribution to OSU for the 2013-15 biennium. This amount funds ten days of ship use during the biennium, including fuel, supplies, and labor. OUS anticipates an additional 20 days of ship operations to complete future research with an estimated cost of \$600,000 GF for the 2015-17 biennium.
