Measure Description:

Modifies laws governing seizure of abandoned vessels.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Oregon State Marine Board, Oregon State Police (OSP), District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission

Analysis:
