

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure: HB 3342 - MRA

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Measure Description:

Deletes provisions requiring the Employment Relations Board to investigate a petition for representation in a bargaining unit and certify a labor organization as the exclusive representative of employees if presented with signed authorization cards by a majority of employees. Removes related rulemaking requirements. Deletes provisions providing process by which 30 percent of employees in a bargaining unit may request an election after a majority of workers has signed cards certifying a labor organization; Specifies that measure’s provisions apply to petitions filed with Employment Relations Board on or after the measure’s effective date.

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
