Measure Description:

Allows student with disability to earn credit at community college or public university as part of transition services.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Education Service Districts (ESD), School Districts, Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Department of Education, Oregon University System (OUS)

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This bill makes three major changes with this amendment:

- Allow students with a disability to earn credit from a community college for transition services.
- Allows community colleges developing a program in Public Safety training and/or curriculum development the right to have a facility on land that is otherwise zoned for Exclusive Farm Use;

The agencies affected do not anticipate more than a minimal fiscal impact, however community colleges could see a fiscal impact due to having to insure that transition activities match existing courses or the community colleges may have to develop a course, or courses, that would fit with transition activities. This cost would be borne by the community colleges. The zoning issue would be handled through the local land use process and has a minimal fiscal impact.
