Measure Description:

Extends, by two years, grants distributed to small school districts through State School Fund.

It is assumed that the funding for this extension of the grant program would come from State School Fund and no further appropriations would be made. The current version of SB 5519, the State School Fund bill, assumes passage of this bill.

Department of Education, School Districts

Analysis:
